3,2,1 Here are the 6 most innovative Internet of Things companies to watch in 2017

The Innovation World Cup announces the 2017 winners at the Mobile World Congress in Barcelona.

The 5th IOT/M2M INNOVATION WORLD CUP Pitch and Award Ceremony took place at the heart of the 2017 Mobile World Congress on March 1st. 26 finalists took the stage to pitch their outstanding solutions to an audience of investors, media, executives and Mobile World Congress attendees. These 26 innovative solutions were selected from a pool of over 400 submissions in the 5 categories and 2 special prizes of: Smart City, Industrial, Automotive, Transport & Logistics & Surveillance, Healthcare, Smart Building & Home Automation powered by BSH, and the Security Award powered by Gemalto.

Here are the seven winners of the IOT/M2M INNOVATION WORLD CUP 2017:

The winner in *Smart City* is **IoTool** by [SenLab](#) (Slovenia):

IoTool is a smartphone IoT Gateway, API and Cloud solution. The IoTool API helps developers make a customized solution in a fraction of the time and cost that is usually needed. Among other IoT related tasks IoTool can be used as a smartphone crowd sensing platform in smart cities or prototyping (testing) IoT platform.

The winner in *Industrial* and the *Security Award powered by Gemalto* is **TOSIBOX** by [Tosibox Oy](#) (Finland):

Tosibox was born from the idea that secure remote access doesn't have to be complicated or expensive. With the TOSIBOX® solution anyone can build a secure VPN connection in less than 5 minutes, without the need for an IT department, complicated software installations, network configurations or special skills.

The winner in *Automotive* is **Immotor GO** by [Immotor, LLC](#) (USA):

The Immotor GO is an ultra-portable electric personal vehicle with IoT features on par with luxury vehicles. It syncs to your smartphone, has swappable smart batteries that can power other devices, and will one day autonomously drive itself. It solves the first/last mile commuter problem with style and intelligence. At the heart of the GO is a first-of-its kind power source, the Immotor Super Battery, a safe and eco-friendly power solution that makes it possible for you to GO without limitations.

The winner in *Transport & Logistics & Surveillance* is **Tunnll** by [Tunnll](#) (Spain):

Tunnll transforms existing public transport bus services to smart mobility systems. Tunnll allows any existing transport operator in a small town to serve many more passengers with the same buses and drivers. At the same time, it brings intelligent mobility to town residents: with Tunnll they can ORDER any bus with a smartphone app, like any modern app-enabled ride-sharing or taxi service.

The winner in *Healthcare* is **Headbander** by [Techsource Europe / ULOCS](#) (Sweden):

Headbander measures the progress of dementia on an individual basis, without need for trained staff through onsite analysis. The data collected from tracking body language and movement patterns can be used on dementia patients under home care or in nursing homes.

The winner in *Smart Building & Home Automation powered by BSH* is **SmartyPans** by [SmartyPans Inc.](#) (USA):

SmartyPans is a cooking pan that senses the weight and temperature of ingredients as you cook. The accompanying SmartyPans app uses this data to record and share your recipes in real time, give you step by step cooking instructions and computes the nutrition of food being cooked in real time. Our app also integrates with fitness trackers like fitbit.
